## We Can Help You!

### What is the Prescription Assistance Program?

This program helps qualified people get free or low-cost prescription medications from drug companies or other sources. This free service is provided to you by Lakeview Hospital and Stillwater Medical Group through generous contributions to the Lakeview Health Foundation.

### Who qualifies?

Our program might be able to help you if:

- Your primary healthcare provider is with one of the Stillwater Medical Group clinics.
- You do not have insurance OR your insurance does not cover your prescription drugs.
- You meet the requirements of the company that makes your medication(s).

### How do I apply?

Contact the Prescription Assistance Program's coordinator at **651-430-8582** or talk about this program with your primary healthcare provider at your next appointment.

The program coordinator will talk with you about which medications she can help you get. This will depend on the medicine your doctor ordered for you, the insurance you have, and your household income. If the program can assist you, the coordinator will set up an appointment for you at Stillwater Medical Group. No fee is charged for this appointment.

### What must I bring to my appointment?

When you meet with the Prescription Assistance Program coordinator, please bring your:

- Social Security number
- Social Security Benefits Statement or Form SSA-1099 if you are receiving Social Security benefits
- Most recent U.S. Federal Income Tax Form (Form 1040, 1040EZ, etc.)

You may be asked to bring other information. Please feel free to bring a family member or friend with you to your appointment.
